



How to Deploy Fabric

To take part in the event, there are a few prerequisites that need to be completed in advance. Firstly, you need to have a working Fabric capacity which you will use during the day. There are three options for this:

1. You can sign up for a 60-day Fabric trial, by following the instructions at [Fabric trial capacity - Microsoft Fabric](#). You will need to use a corporate (not personal) account for this.
2. If you already have a Fabric Capacity at your organisation, you can create a new Workspace in that. You may be able to do this yourself (if you are a Fabric Capacity Administrator), or you can ask your administrator to create a Workspace for you. You will need to be a member of the Administrator role on this Workspace.
3. Your organisation can deploy a small Fabric capacity (we recommend F8) and create a Workspace for you to use. You can create a Capacity and pause it via the Azure Portal so as not to incur cost prior to the bootcamp.

Once you have ensured Fabric is available using any of the above methods, your Fabric Administrator needs to ensure the option for "Users can create Fabric items" is enabled.

You will also need an internet connection in order to access Fabric during the workshop. ANS will provide credentials for our guest WiFi, but if you are using an organisational laptop, you should confirm with your administrators in advance that it will be able to join the network.

We will be sending some scripts by email in advance of the workshop. These contain Python code but are saved as text files with a .txt extension and will be contained in a zip file. If you cannot receive this type of content by email, please let us know so we can make alternative arrangements.
